

Hints on filling in the Small Lots of Seed Exemption Form –

You will need form PPQ 587, either as an online application or as a pdf.

Though slightly slower, most people have found the printable pdf form which has to be faxed or posted to APHIS was easier to use than the e-permit (which requires e-authentication and password Level 2 access).

In any case remember there is always a second option if you get stuck.

Name and address : organization is optional

Country of Origin : UK

Scientific Names : put “eligible taxa”, do not list individual species

Port of Arrival : N/A

Intended Use :tick Small Lots of Seed

Means of Transportation : tick “Mail or Express Courier”

Sign and date.

We try to make sure that seeds which you are not allowed to import into the US are listed as such on the website, but we cannot guarantee that we have discovered them all. If the inspectors find a prohibited variety they will remove and destroy it but send you the rest of your order. Please let us know if that happens and we will then list that variety as not available to the US. And of course we will refund your money for that seed.
